Remember your school days ... playgrounds, ovals & courts ... for tennis, cricket, footy, athletics & play ... a tuckshop near the covered “wet area” ... large multi-grade classrooms. It’s all here, including the teacher/principal’s house ... and it’s for sale.

Set on a 5 acre (2.02 ha) lot, this property is overflowing with infra structure. As you enter the driveway, you first arrive at the main school building. High set, with a tuckshop & wet area underneath, the main school building has two access points ... one for students and one for staff. The classroom area can be divided into two rooms, plus a long side room with kitchen facilities. There are high ceilings, ceiling fans & good lighting. Two additional rooms were probably for a sick bay and office.

A covered walkway joins the main building to, a now permanent, large demountable classroom. A second covered walkway joins the classrooms to the boys & girls shower/toilet block. There are two ovals, one with a cricket pitch, and a court for tennis and other court games.

The teacher/principals house is a 3-bedroom 1-bathroom cottage with a semi open plan lounge/dining room and separate kitchen. It has a matching separate single garage.

Water is a feature of the property with a total of 9 water tanks supplemented by a licence to pump from Kandanga Creek.

The former school is approx 5 minutes from Kandanga, less than half an hour from Gympie, 45 minutes from Noosa & 10-15 minutes from the new freeway ...
