You enter to a former sleepout, now a great study/office, before the central hallway takes you past the bedrooms to a lounge/sitting room with a slow combustion heater.

The galley kitchen is full of features with marble benchtops, a 5-burner gas stove & dishwasher ... and a traditional English sink. The dining room, off the kitchen, has direct access through bi-fold doors to a covered rear deck with a rural outlook.

While the two upstairs bedrooms are spacious, the main bedroom has a executive level en-suite. The main bathroom is top shelf ... amazing ... actually, they both are! There is a guest/third bedroom, shower room & separate toilet located downstairs, under the house.
