'The Weekender' is a Colourbond shed that has been completely lined and finished with gyprock inside and then divided into two halves. The first half set up as the lounge and bedroom area with good storage, and the second set up as the kitchen and meals space with kitchen sink and large freestanding gas cooker.

There are two pergolas attached to the shed. The first along the front approx. 6m x 4m with glass sliding doors into the lounge room side, and the second attached to the end of the shed approx. 6m square with direct access into the kitchen. These areas allow for multiple dining and entertainment spaces to be set up to suit everyone's needs.

The property has a composting toilet and numerous tanks for water storage.

This property is off grid with a small solar power system, there is an additional 6 x 9m shed plus a shipping container providing great storage options.

The current owner has built up an extensive range of building materials and supplies, and these will remain at the property for the new owners use.

Lot 9 Amamoor Creek Road is approx. 76 acres (30.76 Hectares) of bushland, with Amamoor South Creek running through. This is a pretty creek filled with large river rocks and a great place to start your exploring as the property runs right up to the peak of the hill.
