Sitting high up on the top side of York Street, with incredible views reaching over the top of Imbil village and beyond, this home on 1,012m2 is as pretty as a picture.

From the outside this cottage sized Queenslander has been meticulously cleaned and professionally painted and has period metal window awnings to match. The exterior of the house is all done!

Climb your way up the front staircase to the north facing sitting porch and enjoy a drink with friends or a private coffee. The house is accessed by sliding glass doors into the cozy living space featuring high ceilings, VJ walls, coloured glass windows and original timber floors.
